

NOTICE OF RACE

Conanicut Yacht Club 2021 J/22 Series – J/22 Fleet #12 Jamestown, Rhode Island

1. RULES

- 1.1 The races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. US Sailing prescriptions, the International J/22 Class Rules and Regulations, and the Sailing Instructions shall also apply.
- 1.2 Racing Rule 44.1 and the International J/22 Class Rules are changed as follows:
 - a. The Two-Turns Penalty is replaced with the One-Turn Penalty
 - b. The J/22 crew weight rule is not in effect.

2. ELIGIBILITY – Racing is open to any J/22 conforming to the International J/22 Class Rules and Regulations. The J/22 crew weight rule is not in effect (this changes International J/22 Class Rules). Non-CYC members will be welcomed and scored in all series. They will be eligible for prizes, but not for CYC perpetual trophies.

3. SCHEDULE – Racing will take place on the following days in 2021:

June 27, July 4, July 11, July 18, July 25, August 1, August 8, August 15, August 22, and August 29

For this Season the schedule is as follows:

- 3.1 The first signal will be made at 1330 on race days. No race will be started after 1600.
- 3.2 When running multiple races, the Race Committee will start the next race as soon as practical following the conclusion of the previous race. The decision to run additional races will solely be at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- 3.3 A minimum of 2 boats must come to the starting area for the Race Committee to start a race.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted online at conanicutyachtclub.org and copies available before racing at the Conanicut Yacht Club.

5. COURSES

The *2021-2023 South Bay Race Chart* shows the marks to be used for racing, unless other special instructions are issued by the Race Committee. The turning marks will be displayed on the course board on the signal boat, showing the order and direction in which they shall be rounded.

6. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

7. SCORING

7.1. All races held on each of the racing dates specified in Notice of Race taken together shall constitute one series.

7.2 A boat sailing in one race shall be scored for all races of the series.

7.3 Rule A9, "Race Scores in a Series Longer than a Regatta," shall be in effect.

7.4 Throw outs:

(a) When fewer than 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 9 or 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 11 or 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

(d) When 13 or 14 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her three worst scores.

7.5 The boat, not the skipper, will be scored.

7.6 A race will be determined to be completed if at least one boat from the fleet sails the course and finishes the race within the time limit.

8. PRIZES will be awarded to boats finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd for the season based on their series scores and will be presented after the last race of the season.
